OVERVIEW

Pediatrics 2009 is designed to address those clinical issues that are of particular interest to general pediatricians and other health professionals who care for infants, children and adolescents. Based on input from Colorado Chapter American Academy of Pediatrics members and recommendations from the Department of Education at the national AAP headquarters, topics and speakers have been chosen to guarantee presentations that are current and evidence based. There will be ample opportunity for discussion after all presentations. Attendees can expect to gain or reinforce knowledge in the recognition and management of clinic problems in preventive care, allergy, mental illness and dermatology. Vigorous dialogue between faculty and attendees will be encouraged and facilitated.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

After attending this conference, participants should expect to be able to:

- More effectively discuss with parents and manage common problems in rearing toddlers. The "Fast Food Rule," 3 steps for translating statements into a toddler's primitive style of language (toddler-ese), and four ways to prevent temper tantrums.
- Recognize, treat, and appropriately refer pediatric patients with allergic gastrointestinal disorders
- Participate in the management of children with mental disorders requiring psychotherapeutic medications
- More rigorously promote and support breast feeding and more effectively manage common problems encountered by breast feeding mothers
- Provide guidance and support to parents who have children with sleep problems
- Identify the different presentations of atopic dermatitis and train parents and patients in appropriate dermatitis skin care

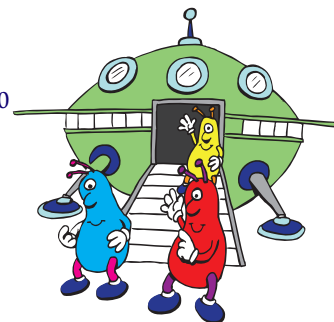
